Academic

Year 7 Transition

The Year 7 Transition model has increased top two classes therefore resources and expenditure has doubled. The Attendance of students is very strong and they have made good or exceptional progress in reading ages and in core skills.

Academic Resources

All Pupils Premium students received free revision guides for all curriculum subjects.

Music

As an Arts College we encourage students to participate in individual and/or group music tuition with peripatetic specialists. Expenditure increased significantly due to the high uptake amongst Pupil Premium students.

Pastoral Support

Student Counselling Service

Additional days have been purchased from our Psychotherapist and Counsellor due to an increase in need to support students' emotional health and wellbeing.

Travel

The need for financial support for students travel increased by 300% compared to the previous year.

Educational Visits

The school promotes curriculum enrichment and encourages all students to participate in Educational Visits and Residential Visits. Costs for these are supported for Pupil Premium students by 25% and Looked After Children at 50% of the overall cost.
