

Key Stage 5 (16 to 19) Results Information 2016

- Progress students have made in English and Maths
 - English students made positive 0.10 progress compared with national - no disadvantaged students were included in this measure
 - Mathematic students made negative 0.452 progress compared with national – our disadvantaged students made negative 0.983 progress compared with national
- Progress students have made compared with students across England
 - Academic progress by students compared to national was a negative 0.33 with disadvantaged students a negative 0.41.
 - GCE A level progress by students compared to national was a negative 0.32 with disadvantaged students a negative 0.34.
 - GCE AS level progress by students compared to national was a negative 0.37 with disadvantaged students a negative 0.57.
 - Applied general progress of students compared to national was a negative 0.63 with disadvantaged students a negative 1.13.
- The average grade that students get at 16 to 19 study
 - The average academic grade achieved by our students in 2016 was C-
 - The average vocational grade achieved by our students in 2016 was Merit+
- Student retention (percentage that get to the end of their study programme)
 - 86% of students on academic pathway completed their study programme
 - 100% of students on an applied pathway completed their study programme
- Student destinations (percentage of students who continue in education or training or move on to employment)
 - Of our students that completed their study in 2014 84% of them went on to Higher (25% and 8% deferred) or Further Education or employment with training. No NEETs were recorded
